Templemoor has been awarded the Music Mark certificate in recognition of the fantastic musical opportunities that occur here. These include;

- Trafford Music Service projects. Generously funded by the Friends of Templemoor, children from Reception to Year 2 have access to a Trafford Music Service project that lasts for a term. Projects finish with a celebration assembly for children to showcase their learning to parents.
- Children from Reception to Year 2 have a weekly music teaching session using the highly acclaimed music scheme, Charanga. Children in Nursery have a weekly music teaching session delivered by the class teacher.
- Singing is delivered and celebrated throughout the school both in assemblies for KS1 and in classes from Nursery to Year 2. Singing is used as a means to teach non-music subjects, as well as in music itself and also purely for enjoyment.
- Termly parent assemblies where children can practise and refine their performance skills, demonstrating their learning to an audience.
- Year group Christmas performances for parents from Nursery to Year 2.
- Opportunities to listen to live music with visits from the Moorlands Junior School Choir and Recorder group and musical parent visitors.
- Use of a published Listening scheme to enhance and develop children's musical knowledge and experience.
