Ancillary duties (for example cleaning up spillages, ensuring tables are clean between sittings etc). 3. Ensuring the maintenance of good order and discipline, using the behaviour policy of the school. 4. Promoting social skills and language skills at lunchtime. 5. Dealing with minor accidents to pupils. 6. Maintaining confidentiality regarding pupils. 7. Reporting any problems to the teacher/Headteacher. 8. To develop lunchtime activities as agreed with the Headteacher. 9. To take part in the in-service training as required. 10. To respect confidentiality at all times.
