
Storysacks

2 RWI Speed Sound Cards



RWI phonic flashcards feature all 31 Set 1 Speed Sounds. This is an enjoyable way to practise the sounds they have learnt in school. Please help your child to learn the speed sounds.

3. Sound blending books



Once children know Set 1 Speed Sounds and are beginning to blend the sounds together they will take home sound blending books.

Continue to practise Set 1 Speed Sounds.

4 Paper Ditties

Ditties are short, phonically decodable passages based on the letter sounds learned in Set 1 Speed Sounds. This provides each child with the opportunity to read simple passages right from the start. Ditties will be sent home to practise.





Continue to practise Set 1 Speed Sounds. Sound blending books may also be appropriate at this stage.



5 RWI Red Ditty Books



Children then begin to read Ditty books. Children will bring home the Red Ditty Book that they have been working on in school. The purpose of this is to 'show off' what they have been learning in school.

RWI Red Book Bag Books





Continue to practise Set 1 Speed Sounds.

Children will also bring home a matched Read Write Inc. Red Book Bag Book. These are engaging texts to support children with additional reading at home. The books are matched to the Read Write Inc. Phonics Storybooks that children are reading in class to reinforce children's learning of phonics at the appropriate level.

6 RWI Green Storybooks



Children then go on the Green RWI Phonics books. Children will bring home the green book that they have been working on in school. The purpose of this is to 'show off' what they have been learning in school.

Children will bring home Set 2 Sounds to practise.

RWI Green Book Bag Books




Children will also bring home a matched Read, Write Inc. Green Book Bag Book.

7 RWI Purple Storybooks



Children then go on the Purple RWI Phonics books. Children will bring home the purple book that they have been working on in school. The purpose of this is to 'show off' what they have been learning in school.

Children then go on the Pink RWI Phonics books. Children will bring home the pink book that they have been working on in school. The purpose of this is to 'show off' what they have been learning in school.


Read Write Inc. Pink Book Bag Books

Children then go on to the Blue RWI Phonics books.




Children will also bring home a matched Read, Write Inc Blue Book Bag Book.

Children are expected to read Grey storybooks with fluency and expression by February half term in Year 2.

13 Book Banded Texts

Children then use class sets of book banded texts to apply phonic knowledge, develop reading fluency and comprehension skills.

Children will now move steadily through the book bands. Children will apply phonic knowledge, improve reading fluency and develop comprehension skills.
